CSULB LONDON SEMESTER

SPRING 2019



CSULB London Semester is offered every spring semester in partnership with CSU Fullerton. Courses are taught by CSULB and CSUF faculty in London, England. The program is open to students with a minimum GPA of 2.6. You pay CSULB tuition; may use your financial aid; and receive CSULB credit for all courses. A 3-unit internship is optional.

COURSES FOR SPRING 2019

Required course:

C/LA 305 (3) British Life & Culture CR/NC

British Life and Culture includes guest lecturers and field trips to the British Museum, National Gallery, & Houses of Parliament, plus weekend field trips. The lectures & visits provide students with a background for British culture & civilization—from examining traditions to understanding contemporary British lifestyle.

CSULB course selections:

Professor Nizan Shaked, CSULB School of Art

AH 432: Museum and Gallery Practices: Writing about Contemporary Art—the London scene

(3 units) upper-division GE, Category C, Writing Intensive, Capstone)

This course is based on field trips to select London museums, galleries, alternative spaces, artist studios, and public art, where students will learn art appreciation, as well as the craft of observation, note-taking, and description.

UNIV 301: London Figures Who Transformed World Cultures (3 units)

[GE, capstone, global issues, writing intensive]

Some of the most significant thinkers, whose work has shaped the world, as we know it today, have lived and worked in London. This course will use London as a lab to study their ideas and discover where they left their mark on the city.

CSUF course selections (on a space available basis):

Professor April Bullock

ART 311: Foundations of Modern Art (3 units) [GE, Arts, capstone]

This course will explore the history of modern art from the French Revolution to the end of the 19th century.

GEOG 373: Global Cuisines (3 units) [GE, capstone]

An interdisciplinary focus on past and present cuisines of London, including migrant cuisines and the relationships between food and empire.

Optional courses:

C/LA 492: INTERNSHIP Unpaid (3 units)—requires UK student visa (approx. \$600) Requirements are regulated by your major department.

DIRECTED STUDY 498/499 Contact your own Department Advisor to see if it is possible to do a Directed Study course in London in your specific major. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 units total. (The internship and directed study can count toward your total 12 units.) Financial Aid recipients must enroll in at least 6 units of CSULB credit. No class changes once in London.
