

Study Abroad Opportunity for HIST 250

Early World Historical Geography - 4 units

The course focuses on the major cultural, economic, social and political and geographical aspects of the Ancient and Classical Periods, examines global perspectives and emphasizes interactions between peoples.

Summer 2018

Depart May 26 - Return June 14, 2018

The course will be based in Rome with apartment housing and university classroom sessions. There are over 25 different site visitations including the Colosseum, Roman Forum, Palatine Hill, as well as many churches, basilicas and museums. There will day trips to Pompeii, Tivoli and Ostia Antica, as well as a visit to Florence.
