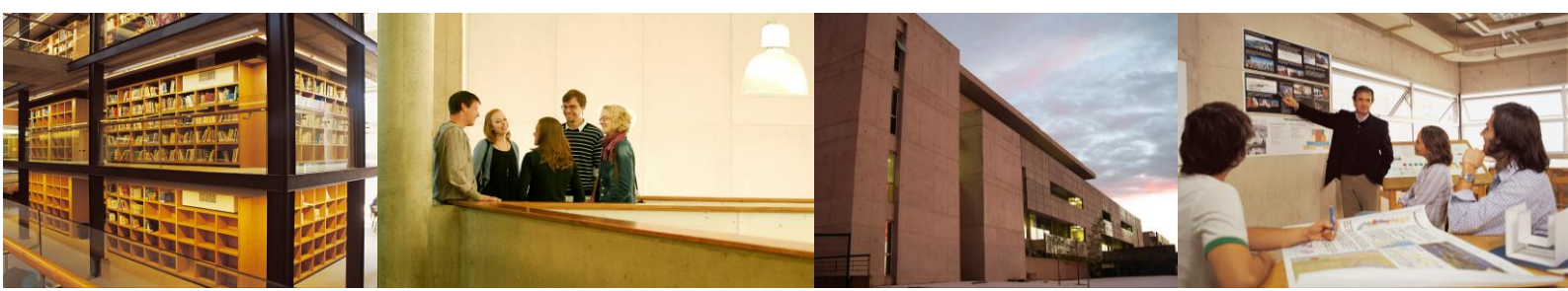

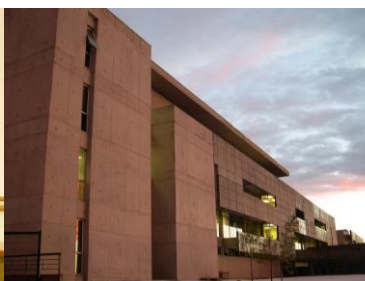
Spanish Language and Chilean Culture Course (only available in Santiago Campus)

No test required. International Students must have a high level of Spanish proficiency in order to attend classes properly.

Mandatory Documents

- All accepted students must apply for the **Student Visa** in the correspondent embassy or consulate.



- All students must take out a **Health Insurance** with international coverage to cover their complete exchange period.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS SERVICES

International students receive academic counselling, a welcome program, tours and different activities during their exchange semester.
